

Aadhaar Seeding with NPCI Mapping Form

How to link your Aadhaar to your bank account for DBT payments

What is Aadhaar Seeding / NPCI Mapping?

For the Government of Maharashtra to transfer your scheme benefit directly to your bank account, your **Aadhaar number must be linked to your bank account**. This link is registered with **NPCI (National Payments Corporation of India)** — the agency that manages India's inter-bank DBT payment system. This process is called **Aadhaar Seeding** or **NPCI Mapper**.

WARNING If Aadhaar seeding is not done, your application will be approved but the payment will FAIL. Complete this step before submitting your application.

How to Seed Aadhaar with Your Bank Account

Choose one of the methods below:

Method	Steps
Bank Branch (Recommended)	1. Visit your home bank branch. 2. Request an Aadhaar Seeding / NPCI Mapper Form from the bank counter. 3. Fill in: Full name, Account number, Aadhaar number, mobile number. 4. Attach a self-attested photocopy of your Aadhaar card. 5. Submit to the bank officer. Seeding is typically processed within 2-5 working days.
Bank's Mobile App / Net Banking	1. Log in to your bank's mobile app or net banking portal. 2. Look for Services > Aadhaar Seeding or Link Aadhaar. 3. Enter your 12-digit Aadhaar number and confirm. 4. Verify with OTP sent to Aadhaar-linked mobile. 5. Seeding is activated within 1-3 working days.
Aadhaar ATM (AEPS)	1. Visit an ATM that supports Aadhaar-based transactions. 2. Select Aadhaar Banking > Link Aadhaar. 3. Authenticate with fingerprint biometric. 4. The seeding is registered immediately.

Documents Required at the Bank Branch

- Aadhaar card (original for verification + self-attested photocopy for submission)
- Bank passbook or cancelled cheque
- Completed Aadhaar Seeding form (available at the bank counter)

After Seeding is Done

After submitting your request, wait **2-5 working days** for the seeding to be processed. You can verify the status using the MahaDBT portal or the NPCI check link. Refer to the separate guide: **Check for Bank Aadhaar Mapping Process**.

INFO Only ONE bank account can be mapped to your Aadhaar at a time for DBT. If you switch banks, you must re-seed the new account and ensure the old mapping is removed.
